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Notes 1: Except for postgraduate students in the Department of Radio, Television, and Film (Division of Production), all master's students in their third year and Ph.D. students from their fourth year onward are charged tuition fees equivalent to those for students under extended study.

Notes 2: Postgraduate students in the Department of Radio, Television, and Film (Division of Production) are required to pay full tuition and miscellaneous fees for the first three years; starting from the fourth year, fees are charged at rates equivalent to those for students under extended study.

Notes3:

(1) For students enrolled in the 2015/16 to 2017/18 academic years, students under extended study are required to pay the basic miscellaneous fees as follows:

- Bachelor's degree: TWD 500 per semester
- Master's degree from the third year onward, and Ph.D. degree from the fourth year onward: TWD 4,500 per semester

(2) For the students enrolled after 2018-2019 academic years, students under extended study are required to pay the basic miscellaneous fees:

- Bachelor's degree: in the first year of extension: TWD 500 per semester, and from the second year of extension onwards: TWD 1,000 per semester
- Master's degree starting from the third year, and Ph.D. degree starting from the fourth year: in the first year of extension: TWD 4,500 per semester, and from the second year of extension onwards: TWD 5,000 per semester

Notes 4: An academic year consists of two semesters. The rates above are calculated on a per-semester basis.

Notes 5: Reference rate is TWD 30=USD 1
